The Westminster Police Department has been notified that the remaining suspect responsible for the double-shooting that occurred on Tuesday, February 2, 2010 at Bishops Garth apartment complex has been arrested in Chambersburg, Pa. The arrest occurred on today's date at approximately 10:00 a.m.

The arrested suspect has been identified as:

Kashon (nmn) HARRIS
Alias: Eric Carter or "E"
Black Male 5'-07" 175 lbs
28 years of age

Troopers from the Pennsylvania State Police, Chambersburg Barrack, received an anonymous tip as to Mr. Harris's whereabouts and arrested him without incident. Mr. Harris is currently incarcerated awaiting an extradition hearing in Pennsylvania.

Mr. Harris has been charged as a fugitive in Pennsylvania based on warrants which were obtained in Maryland shortly after the shootings. These warrants charge Mr. Harris with Attempted Murder, 1st Degree Assault, 2nd Degree Assault and Reckless Endangerment.
