



SIGN ORDINANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting of the Westminster Sign Ordinance Review Committee was held via Zoom and broadcasted live on the City YouTube Channel, on February 15, 2022, at 6 PM.

Committee Members Christine Ameduri, Mike McMullin, Patrick D'Anthony, Tyler Codd, Dana Rogers, and Dean Camlin, were present. City staff members Mark Depo and Andrew Gray were also present.

The following members of the public were present: None. Mr. Gray opened the meeting at 6:00 PM.

Mr. Gray requested a motion to approve the meeting summary from January 4, 2022. Committee member Camlin motioned to approve the meeting summary. Committee member McMullin seconded. The motion passed 4-0.

Item A: Review and Discuss Draft Sign Code (Sections 164-121 to 164-123) - Mr. Gray provided a brief background of proposed sign code sections 164-121 to 164-123.

Committee member Rogers inquired about pixel ratio with different electronic signs and their associated costs. He also mentioned that it would be more feasible for the business owner to approve of the sign instead of both the business and property owner.

Committee member Camlin mentioned to require a drawing for proposed awnings and how awning requirements should be in a separate section of Code.

The Committee suggested replacing square footage with sign area; distinguishing blade signs from wall signs; keeping all signs no higher than the first floor; and sub-categories under prohibitions in windows.

Committee member Ameduri suggested making a distinction between downtown signs vs all other signs when it comes to internally lit signs.

The Committee wanted to look at Frederick's sign code.

The meeting adjourned at 7:22 PM.
