



Dear Valued Community Members and Pool Members,

The City of Westminster understands that the Municipal Pool is an important facility in the community that has served the recreational and leisure needs of a variety of user groups for over 35 years. The pool itself is in serious disrepair that must be addressed immediately to protect and sustain this valuable recreational resource. Unfortunately, the pool will be closed during the summer of 2022, while we make these necessary repairs. We understand that this is incredibly disappointing, but we can assure you it will be worth the wait.

Here's what you can expect as we work hard to improve the Westminster Municipal Pool Complex for the benefit and enjoyment of the community.

Phase I - A carefully renovated and expanded main pool and a new family restroom and filtration building. This phase includes:

- expansion of the main pool by one racing lane,
- an exciting new waterslide,
- new pool decking,
- state of the art, energy-efficient, filtration equipment; and
- a contemporary, aesthetically pleasing structure to house filtration equipment and 4, ADA compliant family restrooms.

We anticipate that Phase I will be complete to allow for a fully operational pool season in 2023.

Phase II – Design and construction of a splash pad and lap learning pool. This phase includes:

- installation of an imaginative splash pad for endless hours of family entertainment and inclusive water play for younger members; and
- construction of an additional, smaller pool to expand programmatic opportunities. A lap/ learning pool will be added for lessons, lap swimming, and other community-based aquatic programming.

Phase II will take place concurrently with Phase I; however, Phase II will take much longer to accomplish. We anticipate the exciting features in Phase II will be ready to serve the community in the summer of 2024.

It is with great pleasure that we can invest in the quality of life in our community through excellent recreational facilities. We hope that these facility upgrades provide you and your family with many years of enjoyment.
